Statement of Deficiencies

1103.A.-D.: Critical Incidents and Required Notifications

1103.A.-D.: An early learning center shall make immediate notification to emergency personnel, law enforcement as applicable, and other appropriate agencies for the following types of critical incidents involving children in care:

- 1. death;
- 2. serious injury or illness that required medical attention;

3. reportable infectious diseases and conditions listed in LAC 51.II.105; and

- 4. any other significant event relating to the health, safety, or well-being of any child, including but not limited to a lost child, an emergency situation,
- fire or other structural damage, or closure of the center.
- B. The parent shall be contacted immediately following any immediate notifications made under Subsection A.
- C. The department and other appropriate agencies shall be notified via email within 24 hours of the incident.
- D. The department shall be notified by written report within 24 hours of the incident or the next business day. This written notification shall be made on
- the department's Critical Incidents Report Form and shall contain all information requested on the form.

Finding:

1103.A.-2,C,& D. Based on record review/interview(s): The provider failed to notify within 24 hours of the incident the Department of a serious injury or illness that required medical attention. Specialist reviewed the incident report which noted that on 12/11/18 at 9:45am, C1 tripped and fell down while walking around the classroom. S3 notified O1of the incident on 12/11/18 at 9:57am. C1 was taken to the doctor by O1 on 12/11/18 and was diagnosed with sprained right ankle .O1 notified S1 of the diagnosis via email on 12/11/18 at 4:10pm. After follow-up appointments on 12/12/18-12/13/18, O1 informed S3 via phone on 12/14/18 (time unknown) that C1's X-rays returned showing a broken right leg (Tibia Fracture). S1 submitted the Critical Incident Report form to the department on 12/18/18 at 11:15am. Child Welfare was not notified of the incident.
