

Statement of Deficiencies

1713.J.: Rest Time Supervision

Not Met

1713.J.: 1. If two rooms share a common doorway, one staff member may supervise the resting children in both rooms.

2. If the view of the staff supervising the children is obstructed by an object such as a low shelving unit, children shall be checked by sight by staff circulating among the resting children.

Finding:

1713.J. Based on observations at approximately 1:40 p.m., S1 failed to ensure 6 children (ages 2 to 3-year-old) were being supervised at all times during nap time as evidence by:

- Upon arrival, Specialist observed all staff on the premises (S1, S2, and S3) in the front classroom. While conducting the walk-through of the center, Specialist observed 6 children, asleep, in the back classroom. This was corrected at 1:41 p.m. when S2 went into the classroom.
- After conducting a walk-through of the play yard at approximately 1:47 p.m., Specialist observed S2 in the front classroom while the 6 children remained asleep in the back classroom. This was corrected at 1:48 p.m. when S2 returned to the classroom.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 1/3/2022, S1 stated he will speak with the center's staff regarding supervision during nap time to ensure the center is not cited this deficiency again.
