Statement of Deficiencies

1501.A.: Operations Not Met

1501.A.: A center shall operate within the licensed capacity, age range, hours of operation and other specific services designated on its license.

Finding:

1501.A. Based on observations:

The Owner/Director did not notify the Licensing Division prior to changing the name of the center. On 1/6/2020, at approximately 1:00pm, upon arrival, specialist observed the signs on the outside of the building read Green Apple Daycare & Learning Center.

1713.A.&B.&C.: Supervision

Not Met

- 1713.A.&B.&C.: A: Children shall be supervised at all times in the center, on the playground, on field trips, on non-vehicular excursions, and during all water activities and water play activities.
- B: Children shall not be left alone in any room, (except the restroom as indicated in Subsection G of this Section or when being provided services by therapeutic professionals, as defined in §103), outdoors, or in vehicles, even momentarily, without staff present.
- C: A staff person shall be assigned to supervise specific children whose names and whereabouts that staff person shall know and with whom the staff person shall be physically present. Staff shall be able to state how many children are in their care at all times.

Finding:

1713.A.&B.&C. Based on observations:

On 1/6/2020, at approximately 2:15pm, S4 walked out of the infant room to make copies on the copier in the office, leaving 4 infants, ages 5 months-1 year old alone in the infant room. S4 was asked who was in the room with the infants and turned around and walked back to the infant room.

Corrective Action: S1 stated she will go over policies with S4 to make sure she understands children are to never be left alone.

1723.A.&B.: CPR Certification Not Met

1723.A.&B.: A. Infant and child CPR. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department.

B. Adult CPR. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in adult CPR through training approved by the department.

Finding:

1223.A.&B. Based on record review:

S1 did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department. Only 2 of 5 staff present had documentation of this certification.

Corrective Action: S1 is unaware of any scheduled trainings and was provided list of department approved trainings.

1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid Not Met

1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in pediatric first aid through training approved by the department.

Finding:

1723.C. Based on record review:

S1 did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in Pediatric First Aid through training approved by the department. Only 2 of 5 staff present had documentation of this certification.

Corrective Action: S1 is unaware of any scheduled trainings and was provided list of department approved trainings.
