Statement of Deficiencies

1911.D.: Awake Children

1911.D.: While awake, children shall not remain in a crib, baby bed, swing, high chair, carrier or playpen for more than 30 consecutive minutes.

Finding:

1911.D. Based on interview(s) on 1/9/2024, at 11 a.m., S5 failed to ensure children did not remain in a crib or bouncer for more than 30 consecutive minutes when awake. On 12/21/2023, O1 and O2 observed, on the center's web-cam, C1, age 11 months, in a bouncer in the Infant Classroom from 7:45 a.m. to 9:38 a.m. C1 remained in the bouncer as S5 interacted with other children in the classroom, was fed in the bouncer at approximately 9 a. m., then placed in a crib for nap.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 1/9/2024, S1 will re-train staff on Care of Children and infants will be rotated every 30 minutes to ensure compliance with the regulation.
