

Statement of Deficiencies

1713.E.&F.: Supervision Participation

Not Met

1713.E.&F.:

E: While supervising a group of children, staff shall devote their time to supervising the children, meeting the needs of the children, and participating with them in their activities.

F: Staff duties that include cooking, housekeeping or administrative functions shall not interfere with the supervision of children.

Finding:

** NEW ** 1713 E. Based on observation :While supervising a group of children, childcare staff did not devote their time to supervision of the children, meeting the needs of the children, and in participation with the children in their activities.

- While completing a walk through of the center during naptime, Specialists observed S11 on her phone while supervising a group of children. S11 did put her phone up when a child walked toward S11. Specialist also observed S14 supervising a group of sleeping children while on her phone. S14 did put her phone up during the walk through.

1909.C.: Infants - Positioning Devices

Not Met

1909.C.: Infants shall not be placed in positioning devices, unless the center has written authorization from a physician to use a positioning device.

Finding:

** NEW ** 1909.C. Based on observations: Written authorization from a physician was not available for 2 of 5 infants, in S9's classroom, to use a positioning device. Specialist observed two infants sleeping swingers.

1919.H.: Infants Held While Bottle Fed

Not Met

1919.H.: Infants that cannot hold a bottle shall be held while being bottle-fed. A child shall not be placed lying down on a mat or otherwise with a bottle, sippy cup, etc. A bottle shall not be propped at any time.

Finding:

** NEW ** 1919.H. Based on observations: Specialist observed an infant with a propped bottle in S9 and S6's classroom . Specialist observed a child placed in a crib holding her bottle in S8 and S7's classroom.
