# Statement of Deficiencies

## 1901.J.&K.: Items That Can be Harmful to Children

1901.J.&K.: J. Items that can be harmful to children, such as medications, poisons, cleaning supplies and chemicals, and equipment, tools, knives and other potentially dangerous utensils, shall kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children. K. Plastic bags, when not in use, regardless of purpose or use, shall be made inaccessible to children.

#### Finding:

1901.J.&K.: Based on observations on 1/17/19, items that can be harmful to children, such as medications, poisons, cleaning supplies and chemicals, and equipment, tools, knives and other potentially dangerous utensils, were not kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children as LS observed an unlocked cabinet in S4 and S5's classroom with a bottle of window cleaner and another bottle of cleaning solution located on a shelf that was accessible to children. LS observed 15 children (ages 3yr to 4yr) in the classroom during the center walk through. LS did not observed S4 or S5 locking the cabinet during the center visit.

LS observed unused plastic grocery bags that were accessible to children in S6 and S7's classroom during the walk through. LS observed S6 and S7 supervising 15 children (ages 3yr to 4yr). LS observed S6 removing the plastic bags during the center visit.

### 1903.E.6.: Outdoor - Crawlspaces

1903.E.6.: Crawlspaces and mechanical, electrical, or other hazardous equipment shall be made inaccessible to children.

## Finding:

1903.E.6. Based on observations on 1/17/19, crawlspaces were not inaccessible to children as LS observed a gate located on the center's playground that failed to be locked and appeared to have a crawlspace large enough for a child to enter/exit the playground area.
