Statement of Deficiencies

1717-A: Independent Contractors Records

1717-A: Independent Contractors. The following information shall be maintained for all independent contractors, including but not limited to therapeutic professionals, extracurricular personnel, contracted transportation drivers, Department of Education, Office of Early Childhood staff and local school district staff:

- 1. an information form that includes the person's name, address and phone number
- 2. a list of duties performed while present at the center; and

3. documentation of a fingerprint based satisfactory criminal background check dated prior to the individual being present at the center or documentation of the paid, adult staff member not otherwise counted in child to staff ratios that accompanied the contractor at all times while the contractor was on the center premises, to include the date, contractor arrival and departure time, language stating that the contractor was accompanied by the staff member at all times while on the premises, and the signature of both the contractor and the accompanying staff member.

Finding:

1717-A. Based on based record review: Provider did not have documentation of a fingerprint based satisfactory criminal background check dated prior to the individual being present at the center for independent contractor O1 and O2. O1 provided a computer based criminal background check under Early Steps dated 10/29/14. O1 has been on premises 10/27/16, 11/8/16, 11/17/16, 11/22/16, and 12/15/16. O2 provided a copy of their certified criminal background check (RTR), however, the provider failed to obtain a new satisfactory criminal background check from the Louisiana State Police for this independent contractor prior to the one year date of issuance of the previous certified criminal background check in order for the individual to continue provided services at the center (1703.E). The criminal background check on file for O1 expired on 9/8/15 and this staff person was present in the licensed child care facility on 3/4/16, 4/21/16, 5/23/16, 6/20/16 and 7/8/16.

1909-G: Infant - Bibs

1909-G: Bibs shall not be worn by any child while asleep.

Finding:

1909-G. Based on observation: The provider allowed a bib to be worn by a child while asleep. Specialist observed C1 asleep with a bib around the neck. Corrected at the time.

1915-A: Health Services - Observation

1915-A: Observation. Upon arrival at the center, the physical condition of each child shall be observed for possible signs of illness, infections, bruises or injuries, and when something is observed, it shall be documented and such documentation shall include an explanation from the parent or child.

Finding:

1915-A Based on record review: The provider did document observations, when something is observed, noted on children upon arrival to the center. Results including an explanation from parent and/or child were NOT always documented.

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
