Statement of Deficiencies

1903.E.5.: Outdoor - Enclosed

1903.E.5.: Outdoor play space shall be enclosed with a permanent fence or other permanent barrier in a manner that protects children from traffic hazards, prevents children from leaving the premises without proper supervision, and prevents contact with animals or unauthorized persons.

Finding:

1903.E.5. Based on observations at 2:55 pm, the fence on the center playground failed to have a gate door installed to protect and prevent the children from leaving the premises without proper supervision, traffic hazards and to prevent contact with animals or unauthorized persons. S1 stated the children had not been going out onto the playground.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 1/20/2021, S1, the director, stated she will ensure the gate door is installed as soon as possible to ensure this deficiency is not re-cited. The company installing the new fence is building the gate door and it should be ready within the next two weeks.
