Centers shall have at least one staff member on the premises and accessible to children trained in Adult CPR if there is a child eight years or older on the premises.

1723-A.&.B: Based on record review: The center did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in infant and child CPR. 2 of 6 staff had documentation of this certification during the licensing visit.

1723-C.-D.: Pediatric First Aid Not Met
