

## Statement of Deficiencies

### 1901-G.&H.: Equipment

Not Met

1901-G.&H.: All equipment used by children shall be maintained in a clean and safe condition and in good repair. Moveable equipment shall be secured and supported so that it shall not fall or tip over.

#### Finding:

1901-G.&H. Based on observations. Specialist observed a climbing plastic toy in the front play yard was cracked on the landing part. Specialist observed 2 plastic playhouses in the front play yard that came apart along the toys joints. S2 corrected prior to specialist's departure.

### 1901-Q: The Safety Box

Not Met

1901-Q: The center shall post a copy of the current The Safety Box newsletter issued by the Louisiana Office of the Attorney General and shall immediately remove from the early learning premises any items listed as recalled.

#### Finding:

1901-Q Based on observations: The center did not post 'The Safety Box' newsletter issued by the Louisiana Office of the Attorney General. The most recent posting was January - March 2017.

### 1915-B.&C: Health Services - Parental Notification

Not Met

#### 1915-B.&C:

B. Reporting. Incidents, injuries, accidents, illnesses, and unusual behavior shall be documented and reported to the parent no later than when the child is released to the parent or authorized representative on the day of the occurrence.

C. Immediate Notification. The parent shall be immediately notified in the following circumstances:

1. blood not contained in an adhesive strip;
2. head or neck or eye injury;
3. human bite that breaks the skin;
4. animal bite;
5. impaled object;
6. broken or dislodged teeth;
7. allergic reaction skin changes (e.g. rash, spots, swelling, etc.);
8. unusual breathing;
9. symptoms of dehydration;
10. temperature reading over 101° oral, 102° rectal, or 100° axillary; or
11. injury or illness requiring professional medical attention.

#### Finding:

1915-B&C: Based on record review: The center did not have documentation of immediate notification to the parent when the following occurred to a child: child's eye was scratched by another child. Incident occurred at 10:40am on 12/1/17 and the center failed to document time of parental notification. On 2 other incident/accident reports the center failed to document date of incident & time of parental notification. On 11/3/17, 2 children bumped heads, the center failed to completed incident report & document parental notification for each child.

### 1919-H: Infants Held While Bottle Fed

Not Met

1919-H: Infants that cannot hold a bottle shall be held while being bottle-fed. A child shall not be placed lying down on a mat or otherwise with a bottle, sippy cup, etc. A bottle shall not be propped at any time.

#### Finding:

1919-H Based on observations: Specialist observed a child sleeping in a crib with a bottle laying flat on the mattress in the child's mouth. S4 removed bottle from crib.
