The following information shall be maintained for all independent contractors, including but not limited to therapeutic professionals, extracurricular personnel, contracted transportation drivers, Department of Education, Office of Early Childhood staff and local school district staff:

- 1. an information form that includes the person's name, address and phone number
- 2. a list of duties performed while present at the center; and

3. documentation of a fingerprint based satisfactory criminal background check dated prior to the individual being present at the center or documentation of the paid, adult staff member not otherwise counted in child to staff ratios that accompanied the contractor at all times while the contractor was on the center premises, to include the date, contractor arrival and departure time, language stating that the contractor was accompanied by the staff member at all times while on the premises, and the signature of both the contractor and the accompanying staff member.

Finding:

1717-A Based on record review: Provider did not have an information an information form that includes the person's name, address and phone number, and a list of duties performed while present at the center for O1, O2, and O3.

1915-A: Health Services - Observation

1915-A: Upon arrival at the center, the physical condition of each child shall be observed for possible signs of illness, infections, bruises or injuries, and when something is observed, it shall be documented and such documentation shall include an explanation from the parent or child.

Finding:

1915-A Based on record review: Daily observation documented by staff did not include whether the explanation was provided by parent, child, or other for all documented observations. Specialist reviewed daily observations dated 12/27/16-01/24/17.

Specialist also observed that daily observations were not completed on every child everyday as required per the 08/05/16 Early Childhood Newsletter.
