

## **Statement of Deficiencies**

### **1901-J.&K.: Items That Can be Harmful to Children**

**Not Met**

1901-J.&K.: Items that can be harmful to children, such as medications, poisons, cleaning supplies and chemicals, and equipment, tools, knives and other potentially dangerous utensils, shall kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children. Plastic bags, when not in use, regardless of purpose or use, shall be made inaccessible to children.

#### **Finding:**

1901-J&K: Based on observations and interviews: Items that can be harmful to children, such as cleaning supplies and chemicals and equipment, were not kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children. Specialist entered classroom #8 and observed a bottle of dish soap in the bottom cabinet beneath the sink. Specialist also found that the cabinet beneath the changing table was not locked and bleach, Tide, and other chemicals were stored there. Specialist found that the Janitor's closet and Electrical closet on the hallway were unlocked. Specialist observed that cleaning supplies and chemical were stored in these closets as well. S1 stated that she was never advised that these closets needed to be locked; however, she would correct.
