

Statement of Deficiencies

713.A: Office of Public Health, State Fire, City Fire, Office of Early Childhood approval

Not Met

713.A: Current approvals by the Office of Public Health, Office of State Fire Marshal, City Fire (if applicable), Office of Early Childhood and the Licensing Division shall be required before the expiration of an existing license.

Finding:

713.A Based on record review: The center failed to have documentation of a current annual inspection and approval from Office of Public Health. The last inspection was conducted on 1/24/2017.

1901-G.&H.: Equipment

Not Met

1901-G.&H.: All equipment used by children shall be maintained in a clean and safe condition and in good repair. Moveable equipment shall be secured and supported so that it shall not fall or tip over.

Finding:

1901-H: Based on observations: On 1/25/18, specialist observed two televisions in the center that were not properly secured. In classroom one, television was sitting on a television stand and was accessible to the children. In classroom three, television was sitting on a small, red plastic children's table and was accessible to children.

1901-J.&K.: Items That Can be Harmful to Children

Not Met

1901-J.&K.: Items that can be harmful to children, such as medications, poisons, cleaning supplies and chemicals, and equipment, tools, knives and other potentially dangerous utensils, shall kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children. Plastic bags, when not in use, regardless of purpose or use, shall be made inaccessible to children.

Finding:

1901-K: Based on observations: On 1/25/2018, specialist observed in classroom one, 2 tubes of Desitin diaper rash cream and 1 box of Children's Tylenol on the bottom shelf of the children's cubby. These items were accessible to children. In classroom 2, specialist observed 1 bottle of Sheer body lotion, 1 bottle of Capri Breeze lotion, and 1 bottle of liquid paper in an unlocked teachers drawer accessible to children. These items had a label that stated that should be kept out of reach of children. In classroom three, 2 pair of adult scissors were in an unlocked drawer and 1 tube of After-Bite Ointment in an unlocked drawer accessible to children. Staff placed all items in a secured area prior to specialist leaving the classroom.

1901-P: Staff Personal Belongings

Not Met

1901-P: The personal belongings of center staff members shall be inaccessible to children.

Finding:

1901-P Based on observations: On 1/25/2018, specialist observed a staff purse in a chair behind the teacher's desk. Staff removed the purse.
