1921.E.: Tornado drills shall be conducted at least once per month in the months of March, April, May, and June at various times of the day necessary to include all children and shall be documented.

Finding:

1921.E. Based on record review/Interview: On 02/04/2020 at 12:15pm, S1 failed to have documentation that Tornado drills were conducted at least once per month in the months of March, April, May, and June. The date of the Tornado drill conducted was 03/01/2019.

Corrective Action Plan: S1 stated she will conduct Tornado drills at least once per month in the months of March, April, May and June at various times of the day to include all children and maintain documentation.
