

Statement of Deficiencies

705.A.B.C.D.: Access

Not Met

705.A.B.C.D.: A. An early learning center shall allow the Licensing Division staff access to the center, the children, and all files and records at any time during any hours of operation or any time a child is present.

B. Licensing Division staff shall be allowed to interview any center staff person deemed necessary by the Licensing Division.

C. Licensing Division staff shall be admitted into a center immediately and without delay and shall be given free access to all areas of a center, including its grounds.

D. If any portion of a center is set aside for private use by an owner of the center, Licensing Division staff shall be permitted to verify that no children are present in that portion of the center and that such private areas are inaccessible to children.

Finding:

705.A. Based on interview(s): Based on interview with S1, Licensing Specialist was not allowed to view the video she had of the incident on 1/31/17, where C1 fell out of a highchair and injured his head, at the time of Specialist visit. S1 stated that her attorney advised her not to show the video to anyone.

1903-C: Free of Hazards

Not Met

1903-C: Indoor and outdoor areas shall be free of hazards.

Finding:

1903-C Based on interview(s): The indoor area was not free of hazards as on 1/31/17, C1 fell backwards in a high chair and cut his head on a nail protruding from the panelled wall. S3 said that she believed C1 hit his head on a nail in the wall when he fell backwards. The Licensing Specialist did not observe any nails protruding from the panelled wall.
