

Statement of Deficiencies

309.A.15: Harmful Objects

Not Met

309.A.15: The provider keeps items that can be harmful to children, such as medications, poisons, cleaning supplies and chemicals, and equipment, tools, knives, and other potentially dangerous utensils in a secure place that is inaccessible to children.

Finding:

309.A.15 Based on observations: Bathroom cleaning supplies & personal hygiene items were not securely placed and left within reach of the children. Items were in bottom bathroom cabinet and on the floor in 2nd bedroom.

309.A.16: Safety Hazards

Not Met

309.A.16: Identify and protect children from safety hazards in the residence and on the premises, such as uncovered electrical outlets, strings and cords, bodies of water, and vehicular traffic.

Finding:

309.A.16 Based on observations: Electrical cords were loose and accessible to the children being cared for in back living room.

309.A.17: Emergency Contact Information

Not Met

309.A.17: The provider has appropriate emergency phone numbers, such as fire and police, hospitals and Louisiana Poison Control, and the physical address and phone number for the residence in which care is provided posted in a prominent, easily visible location, and has a written emergency plan that protects children in the event of fire, flood, storm, hurricane, tornado, and snow and ice.

Finding:

309.A.17 Based on record review/interview(s)/observations: The provider does not have phone numbers in the residence where care is being provided.; The provider does not have appropriate emergency phone numbers, such as fire and police, hospitals and Louisiana Poison Control, and the physical address and phone number for the residence in which care is provided posted in a prominent, easily visible location. The provider does not have a written emergency plan that protects children in the event of fire, flood, storm, hurricane, tornado, and snow and ice.
