

## ***Statement of Deficiencies***

### **1725.A.-C.: Medication Management Training**

**Not Met**

1725.A.-C.: A. All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.

B. Whether the center is administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration and at least one on the premises. A staff member who is a licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved child care health consultant.

#### **Finding:**

1725.A.-C. Based on record review: On 2/10/2020, at approximately 12:10pm, S1 failed to have at least two staff members trained in medication administration whether the early learning center administers medication or not. S1 provided Specialist with three certificates from S3, S5 and S7 for completion of medication administration training. However, the training was not given by an approved provider.

Corrective Action Plan: S1 attempted to contact the center's Educational Specialist, but was unable to reach her. She stated the Educational Specialist is the person who schedules all of the trainings. A training with an approved trainer will be scheduled when the Educational Specialist responses back.

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
