

Statement of Deficiencies

1725.A.-C.: Medication Management Training

Not Met

1725.A.-C.: A. All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.

B. Whether the center is administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration and at least one on the premises. A staff member who is a licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved child care health consultant.

Finding:

1725.A.-C. Based on record review/interview(s) at 9:55am on 2/11/20:Whether the center is administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration and at least one on the premises. The center failed to have any staff trained in medication administration. The Specialist observed that no staff present at the center had documentation of Medication Administration training.

Corrective Action Plan: S1 stated she will be scheduling a training course with an approved trainer once one becomes available. The Specialist observed S1 contacting and leaving a message for a health consultant to schedule a medication training course for staff.
