

## Statement of Deficiencies

### 1911-K: Hand Washing

Not Met

1911-K: Staff and children shall wash their hands using soap at least at the following times: upon arrival at the center, before preparing or serving meals, before giving medication, after playing in water used by more than one person, after toileting, after helping a child use a toilet or changing diapers, after wiping noses or cleaning wounds, after handling pets and other animals, after playing in sandboxes, before eating meals or snacks, upon coming in from outdoors, after cleaning or handling garbage and anytime hands become soiled with body fluids, such as urine, saliva, blood or nasal discharge.

#### Finding:

1911-K: Based on observations: Staff did not wash their hand with soap as needed. Licensing Special observed that staff did not wash their hands after coming inside from outside and prior to preparing children's lunch. Specialist observed S3 enter building 2 and supervise children while another staff washed the children's hands. S3 then began preparing the children's plates without washing her hands. Specialist observed S10 come inside from the play yard with a group of children. Specialist observed S10 supervise the class as they washed their hands; however, S10 failed to wash her hands. S10 then began preparing lunch for the class without washing her hands. Specialist observed both S3 and S10 put on gloves; however, S3 and S10 had not washed their hands. Provider corrected prior to Specialist departure.

### 1915-A: Health Services - Observation

Not Met

1915-A: Observation. Upon arrival at the center, the physical condition of each child shall be observed for possible signs of illness, infections, bruises or injuries, and when something is observed, it shall be documented and such documentation shall include an explanation from the parent or child.

#### Finding:

1915-A Based on observations/interview(s): The provider did not document observations, when something is observed, noted on children upon arrival to the center. Results including an explanation from parent and/or child were not documented. At time of inspection, Specialist observed C1 with scratches next to his eye and mouth. Specialist also observed C2 with rashes (eczema) on her wrist and forearm. Specialist reviewed daily observations and found these were not documented.
