Not Met

1509-A.9: Electronic Devices Policy that provides that all activities involving electronic devices, including but not limited to television, movies, games, videos, computers and hand held electronic devices, shall adhere to the following limitations:

- a. Electronic device activities for children under age two are prohibited; and
- b. Time allowed for electronic device activities for children ages 2 and above shall not exceed 2 hours per day.

Finding:

1509-A.9 Based on observations: S1 and S2 did not follow the Electronic Devices Policy as Electronic Devices were used by children under age 2. During headcount, specialist observed 7 infants watching cartoons in S1 and S2's classroom. Deficiency was corrected during Licensing visit.

1909-C: Infants - Positioning Devices

Not Met

1909-C: Infants shall not be placed in positioning devices, unless the center has written authorization from a physician to use a positioning device.

Finding:

1909-C Based on observations/record review: Written authorization from a physician was not available for 1 of 13 infants in Building 1 to use a positioning device. During headcount, Specialist observed C1 sleeping on a positioning device. Upon review of C1's file, no authorization from a physician could be located. Deficiency was corrected during Licensing visit.
