## 1909.C.: Infants - Positioning Devices

1909.C.: Infants shall not be placed in positioning devices, unless the center has written authorization from a physician to use a positioning device.

## Finding:

1909.C. Infants-Positioning Devices. Based on observations: On 2-18-19 written authorization from a physician was not available for 1 of 9 infants to use a positioning device to assist while sleeping. Specialists observed infant sleeping in a positioning device inside of crib. S1 stated there was no written authorization from a physician due to it being the child's first day at the center. Staff removed infant and positioning device from crib before specialists exited the room.
