

Statement of Deficiencies

1721-A. - C.: Continuing Education Training

Not Met

1721-A. - C.: Early learning centers shall provide opportunities for continuing education of staff members. The center staff of Type III centers, excluding Foster Grandparents, shall obtain a minimum of 12 clock hours of training annually in the topics found in §1719(A) and (B) conducted by trainers approved by the Licensing Division. The Licensing Division shall keep a registry of approved trainers.

B. These Hours are in addition to the 3 hours required for health and safety.

C. Copies of certificates of completion or attendance records shall be maintained at the center and available for inspection by the Licensing Division upon request.

Finding:

1721-A. - C. Based on record review: There was no documentation that the center staff of Type III centers, excluding Foster Grandparents, obtained a minimum of 12 clock hours of training annually in the topics found in 1719(A) and (B) conducted by trainers approved by the Licensing Division. This is in addition to the required training from the Department of Health, Pediatric First Aid and Infant/Child/Adult CPR. Specialist reviewed documentation and found S12 has 16hrs, S13 has 8.5hrs, S14 has 6hrs, S17 has 4hrs, S18 has 4hrs, S11 and S23 have none.
