

Statement of Deficiencies

1901.J.&K.: Items That Can be Harmful to Children

Not Met

1901.J.&K.: J. Items that can be harmful to children, such as medications, poisons, cleaning supplies and chemicals, and equipment, tools, knives and other potentially dangerous utensils, shall be kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children.

K. Plastic bags, when not in use, regardless of purpose or use, shall be made inaccessible to children.

Finding:

1901.J. Based on observation on 2/21/2019, Specialist observed a green medium sized tape packaging dispenser with a sharp cutting edge sitting on top of a small clear container in S18's classroom. The dispenser was on the first shelf of the small white cabinet and was in reaching distance of the children. Specialist also observed an unlocked white 4 shelf cabinet that contained 2 cans of Tat disinfectant cleaner. The cleaner was sitting on the first shelf and was in reaching distance of the children. S1 locked up all items.

1901.P.: Staff Personal Belongings

Not Met

1901.P.: The personal belongings of center staff members shall be inaccessible to children.

Finding:

1901.P. Based on observations on 2/21/2019, Specialist observed an unlocked white cabinet with four shelves in S18's classroom that had a Michael Kors purse sitting on the second shelf. The purse was accessible to the children. S1 locked the cabinet.
