

Statement of Deficiencies

1903.C.: Free of Hazards

Not Met

1903.C.: Indoor and outdoor areas shall be free of hazards.

Finding:

1903.C. Based on record review/video review/interview(s): The indoor area was not free of hazards as on 2/9/2021 at 1:05 p.m., C1, a five-year-old child, found an unmarked white capsule (pill) on the floor while lying on a cot during naptime. C1 brought the pill home to his mother, O1, who reported it to S1 at the center. The unknown pill posed a hazard if ingested by C1 and caused an allergic reaction.

Corrective Action Plan - S1 stated effective 02/10/2021, staff will inspect the floors and areas where children sleep daily prior to naptime. Staff will question children and parents in the morning if the children have any items in their pockets and bags.
