7373-B.8: Appropriate Labeled Sleeping Arrangements

Not Met

7373-B.8: Individual and appropriate sleeping arrangements must be provided for each child. State and local health requirements regarding sleeping arrangements must be met. Each child shall provide or be provided with a mat, cot or bed age appropriate. Playpens shall not be substituted for a baby bed/crib. While in use, each mat, cot or bed shall be placed 18 inches apart and shall be arranged in a head to toe configuration. Each one shall be labeled for individual use.

Finding:

7373-B.8 Based on observations: Provider failed to have appropriate sleeping arrangements for each child in care to ensure his/her health and safety as evidenced by the presence and/or use of a recalled crib(s) on the childcare premises. 3 of 6 cribs observed by the licensing specialist did not meet the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) requirements for full-size cribs as defined in 16 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 1219, and/or non full-size cribs as defined in 16 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 1220.
