2103.D.: Vehicle Staff

1. When transporting children under age 4, the driver and one staff person shall be in each contracted or center provided vehicle at all times.
2. When transporting children age 4 and older, the driver plus one staff member shall be in each contracted or center provided vehicle at all times, unless the vehicle has a communication device which allows the driver to contact emergency personnel, in which case only the driver is needed.
3. At least one staff member in the vehicle and accessible to children shall have current certification in infant and child CPR.

Finding:

2103.D.3. Based on observation at 3:18 pm and 3:26 pm, there failed to be at least one staff member in the vehicle and accessible to the children with a current certification in infant and child CPR. S3 was observed at 3:18 pm transporting children on the center vehicle and there failed to be another staff on the vehicle with certification in infant and child CPR. S4 was observed at 3:26 pm transporting children on the center vehicle. There failed to be another staff on the vehicle with current certification in infant and child CPR. S1 stated both S3 and S4 took the training but their CPR cards have not been received. S1 attempted to get the cards from the instructor while the Specialist was present.

Correct Action Plan: S1 stated effective 2/27/2020, she will ensure that staff who transport the children on the center vehicle have current certification in infant and child CPR. In the event the driver does not have the current certification, a staff with the current certification will be placed on the center vehicle with the driver.
