

Statement of Deficiencies

1725.A.-C.: Medication Management Training

Not Met

1725.A.-C.: A. All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.

B. Whether the center is administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration and at least one on the premises. A staff member who is a licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved child care health consultant.

Finding:

1725.A.-C. Based on record review at approximately 11:02 am, S1 failed to have documentation of at least two staff members with current medication administration training. The staff's training expired on June 24, 2019. S1 stated she sent a text message to the trainer during the department's inspection. She received a call from the trainer, who stated he may be able to schedule the staff for training on Saturday 2/29/2020 after he gets back to his office to check his schedule.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective today, S1 stated she will place a sticky note on the calendar prior to the expiration date as a reminder.
