Statement of Deficiencies

1901.B.: Lighting Not Met

1901.B.: Areas used by children shall be lighted in such a way as to allow visual supervision of the children at all times.

Finding:

1901.B. Based on observations 02/28/19, The areas used by children were not lighted in such a way as to allow visual supervision of the children at all times. S3 stated that the night light went out. Specialist observed the room to be too dark to see the children, S1 who was present during the walk through, turned on the light so that the census could be verified. Specialist observed twelve children ages 2-3 years of age napping in this room. S3 was advised that there had to be enough light in the room to see all of the children.

1909.C.: Infants - Positioning Devices

Not Met

1909.C.: Infants shall not be placed in positioning devices, unless the center has written authorization from a physician to use a positioning device.

Finding:

1909.C. Based on observations on 02/28/19, Written authorization from a physician was not available for 1 (C1) of 4 infants to use a positioning device. C1 was observed sleeping in a crib on a "Boppy Pillow", S2 and S1 were asked if C1 had an authorization from a physician to sleep with a positioning device. S1 and S2 stated that C1 did not. S2 corrected this by removing the pillow.
