

Statement of Deficiencies

1901.G.&H.: Equipment

Not Met

1901.G.&H.: G. All equipment used by children shall be maintained in a clean and safe condition and in good repair.

H. Moveable equipment shall be secured and supported so that it shall not fall or tip over.

Finding:

1901.G.: Equipment: Based on Observations/Interviews: On 03/02/2020 at 12:30pm, Specialist observed all of the center equipment used by children was not maintained in a clean and safe condition and in good repair. Specialist observed a slide on the play yard and it's play equipment that was attached to the slide was not in safe condition and good repair as the nails from the toy steering wheel were exposed. S1 explained to Specialist that they have not had a chance to remove the slide and it's play equipment since the last visit on 12/12/2019, but the children have not been on the play yard. Specialist alerted S1 that on the last visit it was stated that the equipment would be removed and it has not been removed off of the premises as of, 03/02/2020.

Corrective Action Plan: S1 stated that starting on 03/02/2020, she would begin going out on the playground prior the children going out to play and check all of the equipment to ensure that all of the play equipment is in safe condition and good repair. S1 stated she will create a log specifically for visual checks of the play yard to be signed and dated to that the play yard is in safe condition. S1 explained that the log will be signed after each visual check prior to the children going outside to play on the play yard.
