Statement of Deficiencies

1725.A.-C.: Medication Management Training

1725.A.-C.: A. All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.

B. Whether the center is administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration and at least one on the premises. A staff member who is a licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved child care health consultant.

Finding:

1725.A.-C. Based on record review/interview at 3:55pm, S1 failed to have at least two staff members trained in medication administration whether the early learning center administers medication or not. S1 stated training was completed on 2/6/2020, however she did not have documentation to verify training. S1 verified the trainers name and O1 was not listed as an approved trainer. O1 has been out of the office with the flu.

Corrective Action Plan: S1 will make contact with O1 on 3/5/2020 to verify if she is an approved trainer. S1 will enroll herself and staff in training for 3/14/2020 if current trainer can not be approved.
