

## Statement of Deficiencies

### 1723.A.&B.: CPR Certification

Not Met

1723.A.&B.: A. Infant and child CPR. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department.

B. Adult CPR. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in adult CPR through training approved by the department.

#### Finding:

1723.B: Based on record review at 12:50PM, S1 failed to have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, had current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department. 0 of 6 staff had documentation of this certification. S1 stated they have a class scheduled for 03/19/2020.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 03/06/2020, S1 will make sure every staff member has CPR training.

### 1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid

Not Met

1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in pediatric first aid through training approved by the department.

#### Finding:

1723.C. Based on record review at 12:50PM, S1 failed to have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, had current certification in Pediatric First Aid through training approved by the department. 0 of 6 staff had documentation of this certification. S1 stated they have a class scheduled for 03/19/2020.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 03/06/2020, S1 will make sure every staff member has Pediatric First Aid training.
