1903.E.5.: Outdoor play space shall be enclosed with a permanent fence or other permanent barrier in a manner that protects children from traffic hazards, prevents children from leaving the premises without proper supervision, and prevents contact with animals or unauthorized persons.

Finding:

NEW 1903.E.5. Based on observations/interview(s): The outdoor play space lacked enclosure with a permanent barrier in a manner that protects children from traffic hazards, prevents children from leaving the premises without proper supervision, and prevents contact with animals or unauthorized persons. Specialist observed two broken latches on the two-sided gate, which opens to Highway 90, of the fence that encloses the outdoor play area. The gate failed to properly stay closed to ensure a a manner that protects children from traffic hazards, prevents children from leaving the premises without proper supervision, and prevents contact with animals or unauthorized persons. S1 stated the owner's husband will fix the fence by 03/15/2021.

Corrective Action Plan: S1 and S2 stated, effective 03/11/2021, a teacher will ensure the gate is properly functioning before children go outside to ensure this deficiency is not re-cited.
