

Statement of Deficiencies

5311-A.4: Health Statement

Not Met

5311.A.4. A record for each paid and non-paid staff person, including substitutes and foster grandparents shall be on file at the center. Personnel record shall include a written statement of good health signed by a physician or designee. Health statement dated within three months prior to offer of employment or within one month after date of employment is acceptable. A health statement is required every three years. Originals shall be presented upon request.

Finding:

7311-A.4. (5311.A.4.) Health records to include documentation of good health, signed by a physician or designee were not available for 2 staff members.

5312-E.1: CPR

Not Met

5312.E.1. A minimum of at least 50 percent of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children at all times shall have documentation of current infant/child/adult certification in CPR. Original cards shall be made available upon request. This training shall be approved by the Department of Social Services prior to acceptance.

Finding:

7312-E.1 (5312.E.1.) The Provider did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children have current approved Infant/Child/Adult certification in CPR. [1] of [4] staff had documentation of this certification.

5319-N.1: Labeled Bottles/Caps

Not Met

5319.N.1. Bottled formula/breast milk shall have labeled bottles and labeled caps/covers with the child's name or initials and refrigerated upon arrival.

Finding:

7319.N.1 (5319.N.1.) [Bottles/Caps/Covers] for infants were not [labeled].

5321-J: Daily Observation of Children

Not Met

5321.J. Upon arrival at the center, each child shall be observed for possible signs of illness, infections, bruises, injuries, physical condition, etc. When noted, results including an explanation from parent and/or child shall be documented.

Finding:

7321.J. (5321.J.) Results including an explanation from parent and/or child were not documented.

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5321-K: Incidents and Accidents

Not Met

5321.K. Incidents, injuries and accidents shall be documented. Documentation shall include name of child, date and time of incident, location where incident took place, description of how incident occurred, part of body involved, and actions taken. Documentation of all incidents/injuries/accidents shall include time of parental notification and signature of person notifying the parent. The parent or designated person shall be notified immediately in the following situations:

- blood not contained in an adhesive strip;
- head injury;
- human bite which breaks the skin;
- any animal bite;
- an impaled object;
- broken or dislodged teeth; or
- any injury requiring professional medical attention.

Finding:

7321-K (5321-K) The Provider did not have documentation of immediate notification to the parent or designated person when the following occurred to a child: [child hit his head on a shelf and had a bump on his forehead]. Incident occurred at [4:00 pm] on [1-12-09] and there was no record that the parent was notified.

5321-L: Illnesses and Unusual Behavior

Not Met

5321.L. Documentation of illnesses and/or unusual behavior shall be maintained. Documentation shall include child's name, type/description of illness or unusual behavior, date and time of onset and actions taken, time of parental notification and signature of person notifying the parent. The parent or designated person shall be notified immediately in the following situations:

- allergic reaction;
- skin changes e.g. rash, spots, swelling, etc.;
- unusual breathing;
- dehydration;
- any temperature reading over 101 oral, 102 rectal, or 100 axillary; or
- any illness requiring professional medical attention.

Finding:

7321.L. (5321.L.) The Provider's documentation of [pink eye] was incomplete as it did not include: time of parental notification and signature of person notifying parent.

5327-O: Fire Drills

Not Met

5327.O. Fire drills shall be conducted at least once per month. These shall be conducted at various times of the day and night (if nighttime care is provided) and shall be documented. Documentation shall include:

- date and time of drill;
- number of children present;
- amount of time to evacuate the center;
- problems noted during drill and corrections noted; and
- signatures (not initials) of staff present.

Finding:

7327.O (5327.O.) Monthly fire drill documentation was not available for February of 2009.
