

Statement of Deficiencies

1915-B.&C: Health Services - Parental Notification

Not Met

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B. Reporting. Incidents, injuries, accidents, illnesses, and unusual behavior shall be documented and reported to the parent no later than when the child is released to the parent or authorized representative on the day of the occurrence.

C. Immediate Notification. The parent shall be immediately notified in the following circumstances:

1. blood not contained in an adhesive strip;
2. head or neck or eye injury;
3. human bite that breaks the skin;
4. animal bite;
5. impaled object;
6. broken or dislodged teeth;
7. allergic reaction skin changes (e.g. rash, spots, swelling, etc.);
8. unusual breathing;
9. symptoms of dehydration;
10. temperature reading over 101° oral, 102° rectal, or 100° axillary; or
11. injury or illness requiring professional medical attention.

Finding:

1915-B.&C Based on record review: The Provider did not have documentation of immediate notification to the parent when the following occurred to a child:

- On 03/07/18, C1 was hit on the right side of his face at 9:40am on 03/07/18. There was no documentation that parents were notified timely.
- On 03/02/18, C2 was scratched on the neck at 11:12am. There was no documentation that parents were notified timely. There was a parent signature for notification on 03/05/18.
- On 01/31/18, C3 was scratched in the face at 11:30am. There was no documentation that parents were notified timely.
- On 01/31/18, C4 was scratched on the left eye at 11:30am. There was no documentation that parents were notified timely.
- On 01/31/18, C5 was hit in the face by a ball at 3:45pm. There was no documentation that parents were notified timely.
- On 01/31/18, C6 was scratched on the left side of the face at 11:25am. There was no documentation that parents were notified timely.
