1507-A: Daily Attendance Records - Children

Not Met

1507-A: A daily attendance record for children shall be maintained that shall:

- 1. include the child's first and last name, arrival and departure times, and first and last name of person or entity to whom the child is released;
- 2. accurately reflect children on the center premises at any given time; and
- 3. be used to sign in and out if a child leaves and returns to the center during the day.

Finding:

1507-A Based on record review: *Daily attendance record for children failed to accurately reflect the number of children who were on the premises on this date as evidenced by: 17 were signed in however 28 were on the premises. ** School age children failed to have been signed out upon departure for school on this date

1901-J.&K.: Items That Can be Harmful to Children

Not Met

1901-J.&K.: Items that can be harmful to children, such as medications, poisons, cleaning supplies and chemicals, and equipment, tools, knives and other potentially dangerous utensils, shall kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children. Plastic bags, when not in use, regardless of purpose or use, shall be made inaccessible to children.

Finding:

1901-J.&K.: Based on observation: Harmful substances failed to be inacessible to children as evidenced by *storage room containing bleach, pine sol and other cleaning supplies was open; **a can of spray disinfectant was locate on high chair in the 4-5 year area.

1901-P: Staff Personal Belongings

Not Met

1901-P: The personal belongings of center staff members shall be inaccessible to children.

Finding:

1901-P Based on observations: Staff purse was located on shelf within reach of children in the four-five year classroom area.

2107.A.1-2: Visual Check of Vehicle

Not Met

2107.A.1-2: A visual passenger check of a vehicle is required to ensure that no child is left in the vehicle.

- 1. A staff person shall physically walk through the vehicle and inspect all seat surfaces, under all seats, and in all enclosed spaces and recesses in the interior of the vehicle.
- 2. The staff member shall record the time of the visual passenger check and sign the log, indicating that no child was left on the vehicle.

Finding:

2107.A.1-2 Based on interview(s): S8 stated records for school transportation failed to be available for today's date 3/14/17 and 3/13/17.

2107-C: Daily Transportation Visual Vehicle Check

Not Met

2107-C: For daily transportation services, the vehicle shall have a visual passenger check made at the completion of each trip or route, prior to the staff member exiting the vehicle.

Finding:

2107-C Based on record review: There failed to be record of visual check completed for school transportation provided on 3/14/17 and 3/13/17.
