

Statement of Deficiencies

1901.J.&K.: Items That Can be Harmful to Children

Not Met

1901.J.&K.: J. Items that can be harmful to children, such as medications, poisons, cleaning supplies and chemicals, and equipment, tools, knives and other potentially dangerous utensils, shall be kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children.

K. Plastic bags, when not in use, regardless of purpose or use, shall be made inaccessible to children.

Finding:

1901.J. Based on observation on 3/19/2019, Specialist observed a green medium sized tape packaging dispenser with a sharp cutting edge sitting on top of a small clear container in S5's classroom. The dispenser was on the first shelf of the small white cabinet and was in reaching distance of the children. S5 locked up the dispenser prior to Specialist departure.

1903.C.: Free of Hazards

Not Met

1903.C.: Indoor and outdoor areas shall be free of hazards.

Finding:

1903.C. Based on observations on 3/19/2019, the indoor area was not free of hazards as Specialist observed a total of 20 wall socket plugs in the gym. 3 of 20 of the wall socket plugs failed to have a cover. In classroom #205, Specialist observed that 2 wall socket plugs failed to have a cover. Plug covers were put in place prior to Specialist departure.
