

Statement of Deficiencies

1501-A: Operations

Not Met

1501-A: A center shall operate within the licensed capacity, age range, hours of operation and other specific services designated on its license.

Finding:

1501-A Based on observations/interview(s):

The Director made changes that had an effect on the license as the provider is licensed to care for children ages 6 weeks to 12 years and children ages 7 months to 13 years were being cared for on the childcare premises. S1 stated C1 is her 13 year old daughter.

1711-H: Rest Time - Minimum Child to Staff Ratio

Not Met

1711-H: Rest Time - Minimum Child to Staff Ratios

1. Sufficient staffing needed to satisfy child to staff ratios shall be present on the premises during rest time and available to assist as needed.
2. Children ages one and older may be grouped together at rest time with one staff member in each room supervising the resting children. If two rooms share a common doorway, one staff member may supervise the resting children in both rooms.
3. If the view of the staff supervising the children is obstructed by an object such as a low shelving unit, children shall be checked by sight by staff circulating among the resting children.

Finding:

1711-H Based on observations:

Upon arrival, Specialist observed S1 was with C1 in the office and S2 in a separate room with 1 child under the age of one grouped together with 8 older children at rest time.

1723-A.&B.: CPR Certification

Not Met

1723-A.&B.: A - Infant and child CPR - Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in infant and child CPR.

B - Adult CPR - Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in adult CPR.

Finding:

1723 A & B Based on record review/interview: The center did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in infant and child CPR. 0 of 2 staff on premises had documentation of this certification.

1723-C.-D.: Pediatric First Aid

Not Met

1723-C.-D.:

- C. Pediatric First Aid - Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in Pediatric First Aid.
- D. Certification - A copy of the certification for each such staff member shall be on-site at all times and available for inspection by the Licensing Division.

Finding:

1723-C.-D. Based on record review/interview(s): The center did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in Pediatric First Aid. 0 of 2 staff had documentation of this certification.
