K. Plastic bags, when not in use, regardless of purpose or use, shall be made inaccessible to children.

Finding:

1901.J & K: Based on observations on 03/21/19, specialist observed items harmful to children in S6's classroom. There was 1 small rolls of trash bags and 1 large roll of trash bags on the changing table within reach of the children. S6 moved both rolls of trash bags to the top shelf of the unlocked cabinet.

1901.P.: Staff Personal Belongings

Not Met

1901.P.: The personal belongings of center staff members shall be inaccessible to children.

Finding:

1901.P. Based on observations on 03/21/2019, S6 had her purse in an unlocked cabinet within reach of children. S6 moved the purse to the top shelf of the unlocked cabinet while specialist was present.

2101.A.9.: Vehicle - Safety Inspection

Not Met

2101.A.9.: Each vehicle shall have evidence of a current safety inspection.

Finding:

2101.A.9. Based on observations on 03/21/2019, the school bus did not have a current safety inspection in the window. S1 stated the church just puchased the bus in June or July of 2018.
