

Statement of Deficiencies

1901-P: Staff Personal Belongings

Not Met

1901-P: The personal belongings of center staff members shall be inaccessible to children.

Finding:

1901-P Based on observations the personal belongings of center staff members S7 was accessible to children on 3/26/18 as evidenced by S7 had a gray backpack purse sitting on a shelf in the classroom area. S7 secured the purse during the visit.

1909-C: Infants - Positioning Devices

Not Met

1909-C: Infants shall not be placed in positioning devices, unless the center has written authorization from a physician to use a positioning device.

Finding:

1909-C Based on observations on 3/26/18, written authorization from a physician was not available for 1 of 6 infants to use a positioning device as evidenced by C1 was asleep in a swing during the walk-through of the center. Specialist advised S1 that C1 cannot sleep in a positioning device unless the child has a doctors authorization. Another child was asleep in a sleeper in the classroom and S1 was informed that there is a difference in a sleeper and a swing. If it is made for sleeping it is alright to sleep in it. S5 removed C1 and placed him in the crib.
