

## **Statement of Deficiencies**

### **1723.A.&B.: CPR Certification**

**Not Met**

1723.A.&B.: A. Infant and child CPR. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department.

B. Adult CPR. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in adult CPR through training approved by the department.

#### **Finding:**

1723.A.: CPR Certification. Based on record review/interview: On 3/26/19, Specialist noted that 6 of 7 center staff failed to produce documentation verifying that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department. S1 stated that all staff completed the required CPR Certification course in February 2019, however the CPR cards have not yet come in for Specialist to verify this information.

### **1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid**

**Not Met**

1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in pediatric first aid through training approved by the department.

#### **Finding:**

1723.C. Pediatric First Aid. Based on record review/interview: On 3/26/19, Specialist noted that 6 of 7 center staff failed to produce documentation verifying that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in Pediatric First Aid through training approved by the department. S1 stated that all staff completed the required Pediatric First Aid Certification course in February 2019, however the cards have not yet come in for Specialist to verify this information.
