

## ***Statement of Deficiencies***

### **1901-J.&K.: Items That Can be Harmful to Children**

**Not Met**

1901-J.&K.: Items that can be harmful to children, such as medications, poisons, cleaning supplies and chemicals, and equipment, tools, knives and other potentially dangerous utensils, shall be kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children. Plastic bags, when not in use, regardless of purpose or use, shall be made inaccessible to children.

#### **Finding:**

1901-J.&K.: Based on observation on 4/9/18, S3 and S4 had Items that can be harmful to children, such as a bottle of bleach in the cabinet under the sink and it was not locked in the cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children. S3 removed the bleach and secured it in another cabinet inaccessible to the children.

### **1911-I.-J.: Proper Lifting of a Child**

**Not Met**

1911-I.-J.: Staff members shall adhere to proper techniques for lifting a child.

Staff members shall not lift a child by one or both arms.

#### **Finding:**

1911-I.-J. Based on observations on 4/9/18, S13 did not lift a child using proper lifting techniques, as evidenced by specialist observed video footage from 4/2/18, at 8:15 am to 8:19 am S13 lifted a child using one arm and one leg. S13 also moved C1 from one position to another on the changing table by one leg while attempting to swaddle C1 in a blanket.
