The provider called in another staff, and per the provider, this staff has current CPR/PFA which the provider stated she is unable to locate. Also, per the staff, she does not have the card or a copy of the card. Corrected during the visit as provider sent one staff home at 10:53am.

7312-E.3: PFA Not Met
