Statement of Deficiencies

1507-A: Daily Attendance Records - Children

Not Met

1507-A: A daily attendance record for children shall be maintained that shall:

- 1. include the child's first and last name, arrival and departure times, and first and last name of person or entity to whom the child is released;
- 2. accurately reflect children on the center premises at any given time; and
- 3. be used to sign in and out if a child leaves and returns to the center during the day.

Finding:

1507-A Based on record review/obseervation: The center's daily attendance record for children did not accurately reflect the children on the child care premises at any given time as 26 children were present and 23 children were signed in on the log upon Specialist's arrival on 4/10/17.

1507-B: Daily Attendance Records - Staff and Owners

Not Met

1507-B: A daily attendance record for all staff members and owners shall be maintained that shall:

- 1. include the first and last name of the staff member or owner and arrival and departure times;
- 2. accurately reflect the staff members and owners on the center premises at any given time; and
- 3. be used to document staff members and owners who leave and return to the center during the day

Finding:

1507-B Based on record review/observation: The center's staff and owner's daily attendance record did not accurately reflect persons on the child care premises at any given time as evidenced by only 2 of 5 staff signed in the log upon Specialist's arrival on 4/10/17. S3 and S5 were the only staff signed in the log.

1509-A.9: Electronic Devices Policy

Not Met

1509-A.9: Electronic Devices Policy that provides that all activities involving electronic devices, including but not limited to television, movies, games, videos, computers and hand held electronic devices, shall adhere to the following limitations:

- a. Electronic device activities for children under age two are prohibited; and
- b. Time allowed for electronic device activities for children ages 2 and above shall not exceed 2 hours per day.

Finding:

1509-A.9 Based on observations: The Provider did not follow the Electronic Devices Policy as Electronic Devices were used by children under age 2. Specialist observed a group of 14 One and Two year old children watching an animated program (Dora the Explorer) on the television while waiting to use the bathroom. There were 6 One year old children in the group.

1715-A.5: State Central Registry

Not Met

1715-A.5: Personnel files for each staff member shall be maintained at the center and shall include the following: documentation of a current, completed state central registry disclosure form indicating no justified (valid) finding of abuse or neglect by the DCFS, or a current determination from the DCFS indicating that the individual does not pose a risk to children.

Finding:

1715-A.5. Based on record review: Provider failed to have documentation of a completed state central registry disclosure form (SCR 1) on site and available for review at the center prior to a previously completed form expiring (1705.B). 1 of 5 staff, S4(DOH: 1/27/16) failed to have documentation of the completed form. The previous SCR 1 expired on 1/22/17. Corrected before departure.

1901-C: End-of-Day Check

Not Met

1901-C: The entire center and play yard shall be checked after the last child departs to ensure that no child is left at the center and this check shall be documented. Documentation shall include date, time of visual check, and signature of the staff conducting the visual check.

Finding:

1901-C Based on record review: The Provider did not document that the entire center and play yard is checked after the last child departs to ensure that no child is left unattended at the center. The last documented visual check of the center was 3/31/17.

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Statement of Deficiencies

1911-K: Hand Washing Not Met

1911-K: Staff and children shall wash their hands using soap at least at the following times: upon arrival at the center, before preparing or serving meals, before giving medication, after playing in water used by more than one person, after toileting, after helping a child use a toilet or changing diapers, after wiping noses or cleaning wounds, after handling pets and other animals, after playing in sandboxes, before eating meals or snacks, upon coming in from outdoors, after cleaning or handling garbage and anytime hands become soiled with body fluids, such as urine, saliva, blood or nasal discharge.

Finding:

1911-K Based on observations: Children did not wash their hand with soap as needed. Licensing Special observed that children did not wash their hands after returning from outdoor play on 4/10/17. 7 - Two year old children under the supervision of S2 did not wash their hands upon returning indoors from playing in the outdoor play area at 10:44 a.m. Also, S2 was observed to wipe the nose of a child and not wash her hands afterwards. S3 utilized a sanitizing wipe on her hands.

1919-A&B: Food Service and Nutrition - Menu

Not Met

1919-A&B: All meals and snacks provided by the center, and their preparation, service and storage, shall meet the requirements for meals of the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) and 7 C.F.R. 226.20 and the Louisiana Sanitary Code, Title 51, Part XXIII, found at LAC 51:XXXIII. For the current CACFP meal patterns, contact the Louisiana Department of Education, Division of Nutrition Support.

The weekly menu shall:

- 1. be planned for each day of the week and list the specific food items served;
- 2. be prominently posted by the first day of each week and remain
b>posted throughout the week; and
- 3. have substitutions or additions posted on or near the menu.

Finding:

1919-A&B Based on observation/record review: The Center's meals, as specified under the Child Care Food Program of the United States Department of Agriculture, were not provided as chicken nuggets, chicken flavored rice, green beans and milk was served for lunch on 4/10/17. An additional serving of vegetables or a serving of fruit was needed to meet the requirements. Also, menu substitutions or additions were not posted on or near the menus as the menu for 4/10/17 specified cheese or pepperoni pizza, corn, applesauce and milk to be served for lunch. The center served chicken nuggets, chicken flavored rice, green beans and milk instead.
