

## Statement of Deficiencies

### 1903.C.: Free of Hazards

Not Met

1903.C.: Indoor and outdoor areas shall be free of hazards.

#### Finding:

1903.C. Based on observations: The outdoor play yard area was not free of hazards as Specialist observed a wooden board on the lattice fence was not attached, exposing large metal staples and screws. Specialist also observed metal strips with sharp corners protruding from chain link fence. S1 stated she will correct by reattaching the board to the lattice fence and weaving the metal strips back into the chain link fence.

### 1903.E.5.: Outdoor - Enclosed

Not Met

1903.E.5.: Outdoor play space shall be enclosed with a permanent fence or other permanent barrier in a manner that protects children from traffic hazards, prevents children from leaving the premises without proper supervision, and prevents contact with animals or unauthorized persons.

#### Finding:

1903.E.5. Outdoor - Enclosed. Based on observations: Outdoor play space lacked enclosure with a permanent fence or other permanent barrier in a manner that protects children from traffic hazards, prevents children from leaving the premises without proper supervision, and prevents contact with animals or unauthorized persons. Specialist observed on 4/10/2019 that the play yard white lattice fence was not connected or latched between two pieces allowing an opening accessible to the children. S1 stated she will have maintenance reconnect and secure the fence.

### 1903.E.6.: Outdoor - Crawlspace

Not Met

1903.E.6.: Crawlspace and mechanical, electrical, or other hazardous equipment shall be made inaccessible to children.

#### Finding:

1903.E.6. Outdoor - Crawlspace. Based on observations: Crawlspace and mechanical, electrical, or other hazardous equipment is not inaccessible to children. Specialist observed on the play ground a wooden board missing from the fence surrounding the air conditioner allowing a space large enough for the children to enter the area. S1 stated she will have maintenance replace the board.
