Statement of Deficiencies

1723.A.&B.: CPR Certification

1723.A.&B.: A. Infant and child CPR. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department.

B. Adult CPR. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in adult CPR through training approved by the department.

Finding:

1723.A.: Based on record review: The provider did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department. 3 of 7staff had documentation of this certification.

1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid

1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in pediatric first aid through training approved by the department.

Finding:

1723.C. Based on record review: The provider did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in Pediatric First Aid through training approved by the department. 3 of 7 staff had documentation of this certification.

1723.D.: Certification - More Than One Building

1723.D.: When a center has more than one building, each building shall have at least one staff member present at all times certified in the CPR and First Aid appropriate for the age of the children present in the building.

Finding:

1723.D. Based on observations/interview/record review: The center has 2 buildings and not at least one staff member present at all times certified in the CPR and First Aid appropriate for the age of the children present in the building. S1 stated S7 is the assigned staff to the classroom in building 2. S7 does not have documentation of CPR and First Aid certification.

1903.C.: Free of Hazards

1903.C.: Indoor and outdoor areas shall be free of hazards.

Finding:

1903.C. Based on record review/observations: The indoor and outdoor area were not free of hazards as specialist observed 4 broken planks of wood scattered throughout the center's play vard. Specialist observed a missing board on the right side of the center's fence, an unassembled wooden play structure/slide combination, and 2 broken toys stored against building 2, accessible to children on the center's play yard.

1911.G.: Pacifier Attached

1911.G.: Pacifiers attached to strings or ribbons shall not be placed around the neck or attached to the clothing of a child.

Finding:

1911.G. Based on observations: A pacifier that was attached to strings or ribbons was placed around the neck of a child. Specialist observed a pink string around the neck of a child in the 1 year old classroom. S4 corrected at the time of survey.

1921.E.: Tornado Drills

1921.E.: Tornado drills shall be conducted at least once per month in the months of March, April, May, and June at various times of the day necessary to include all children and shall be documented.

Finding:

1921.E. Based on record review: The provider did not have documentation of tornado drills that were conducted at least once per month during the months of March, April, May, and June. Date of tornado drills were 03/12/18, 05/30/18 and 06/19/18.
