

Statement of Deficiencies

1715-A.4: Criminal Background Check

Not Met

1715-A.4: Personnel files for each staff member shall be maintained at the center and shall include the following: documentation of a fingerprint based satisfactory criminal background check

Finding:

1715-A.4 Based on record review: S1 and S2 provided a copy of their certified criminal background check (RTR), however, the provider failed to obtain a new satisfactory criminal background check from the Louisiana State Police for this staff prior to the one year date of issuance of the previous certified criminal background check in order for the individual to continue employment at the center (1703.E). The criminal background check on file for S1 and S2 expired on 12/21/2016 and they failed to submit fingerprints for a new criminal background check until 1/6/17 (S1) and 1/9/17 (S2).

-S3 and S4, date of hire for both 4/4/17, failed to have documentation of a satisfactory criminal background check on file prior to being present and working in the center. Provider had documentation that fingerprints were submitted for S3 on 4/3/17 and S4 on 4/4/17. Based on a review of staff attendance logs, S3 and S4 were present in the center on 4/4/17 and their satisfactory criminal background check weren't received until 4/5/2017.

1723-A.&B.: CPR Certification

Not Met

1723-A.&B.: A - Infant and child CPR - Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in infant and child CPR.

B - Adult CPR - Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in adult CPR.

Finding:

1723-C.-D. Based on observations/record review: The Provider did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in infant, child and adult CPR.

- 1 of 3 staff present on arrival had documentation of this certification.

1723-C.-D.: Pediatric First Aid

C. Pediatric First Aid - Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in Pediatric First Aid.

D. Certification - A copy of the certification for each such staff member shall be on-site at all times and available for inspection by the Licensing Division.

Finding:

1723-C.-D. Based on observations/record review: The Provider did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in Pediatric First Aid.

- 1 of 3 staff present on arrival had documentation of this certification.
