Statement of Deficiencies

1907.A.1.&2.: High Chairs Not Met

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- 1. The high chair manufacturer's restraint device shall be used when children are sitting in a high chair.
- 2. Children who are either too small or too large to be restrained using the manufacturer's restraint device shall not be placed in a high chair.

Finding:

1907.A.1.: Based on observation at 10 a.m., S2 failed to use the high chair manufacturer's restraint device while C2 and C3 (one-year-old) were sitting in high chairs. S2 corrected.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 4/11/2022, S1 stated she will retrain staff of this regulation on 4/13/2022 and it will be documented, to ensure this deficiency is not recited.

1909.G.: Infant - Bibs Not Met

1909.G.: Bibs shall not be worn by any child while asleep.

Finding:

1909.G.: Based on observations at 10 a.m., S2 allowed a bib to be worn by a C1 (infant) while asleep in a crib. S2 corrected.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 4/11/2022, S1 stated she will speak with all parents of enrolled children to keep bibs at home. S1 will speak to staff to remind that bibs must be removed before the children enter the center, to ensure this deficiency is not recited., to ensure this deficiency is not recited.

1911.G.: Pacifier Attached Not Met

1911.G.: Pacifiers attached to strings or ribbons shall not be placed around the neck or attached to the clothing of a child.

Finding:

1911.G.: Based on observations at 10 a.m., a pacifier that was attached to strings or ribbons was attached to the clothing of C1 (infant) and C2 (one-year-old). S2 corrected. Technical assistance previously provided on 3/29/2021.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 4/11/2022, S1 stated she will speak with all parents of enrolled children to keep attached pacifiers at home. S1 will speak to staff to remind that attached pacifiers must be removed before the children enter the center, to ensure this deficiency is not recited.
