There was 1 wheel that was missing the metal post that holds the pedal on the tire and the actual pedal. There was another tire that was missing the metal post. The merry-go-round was not repaired prior to Specialist departure. Specialist observed a red and gray metal tricycle that had missing rubber covers on the handle bar that covers the meta1, 1 red, yellow, and blue little tikes cozy coup riding toy that had broken plastic, and a yellow and blue slide that had metal stakes that hold the slide in place that were sticking up out of the ground. S2 removed the toys. Specialist observed that some of the wood border that surrounds the large metal swing is rotted and split and needs to be repaired.
