Finding:

1711.H.: Rest Time-Minimum Child to Staff Ratio: Based on observations at approximately 1:15 p.m., S1 failed to have the required staffing present during rest time to satisfy child/staff ratio as evidenced by S4 had 2 children under the age of one grouped together with 18 one and two year olds at rest time.

CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN: Effective 4/18/2022, S1 stated that she will rearrange staff break times during the scheduled nap time to have 2 staff present with the 1 and 2-year-olds at all times to ensure this deficiency is not re-cited.

1907.C.2.: Sleeping Arrangements Labeled

Finding:

1907.C.2. Sleeping Arrangements Labeled: Based on observations at approximately 1:15 p.m., S1 failed to have cribs assigned and labeled to a child on a permanent basis as evident by 2 infants were present and 0 cribs were labeled.

CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN: Effective 4/18/2022, S1 labeled all cribs in the 1-year-old room to ensure this deficiency is not re-cited.

1919.C.: Food Allergies and Special Diets

1919.C.: Information regarding food allergies and special diets of children shall be posted in the food preparation area with special care taken to ensure that individual names of children are not in public view.
