

Statement of Deficiencies

1713.E.&F.: Supervision Participation

Not Met

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E: While supervising a group of children, staff shall devote their time to supervising the children, meeting the needs of the children, and participating with them in their activities.

F: Staff duties that include cooking, housekeeping or administrative functions shall not interfere with the supervision of children.

Finding:

1713.E.&F.: Supervision Participation: Based on interviews at approximately 10:30am, while supervising a group of children on 04/06/21 at 2:40pm, S14 did not devote their time to supervision of the children, meeting the needs of the children, and in participation with the children in their activities; staff was sweeping the floors while S21 was changing diapers. Two children, C1 and C2 (age 2-years-old), went out the front door, walking down the ramp that leads to the parking lot. S14 was able to reach the children before they went into the parking lot, bringing them back into the classroom.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 4/6/21, S1 stated one teacher is to occupy children at all times if the other teacher is doing something with another group that hinders full supervision.
